Presidential Determination No. 84-8 of May 29, 1984

Sale of Defense Articles and Defense Services to Saudi Arabia Under the Arms Export Control Act

Memorandum for the Honorable George P. Shultz, the Secretary of State, and the Honorable Caspar W. Weinberger, the Secretary of Defense

In accordance with section 36(b)(1) of the Arms Export Control Act (the Act), I hereby certify that an emergency exists which requires the sale under the Act of the following defense articles and defense services to Saudi Arabia in the national security interests of the United States:

- —200 basic Stinger air defense guided missile systems (200 gripstocks with 200 missiles);
- -200 additional missiles;
- —Related support and training equipment, spare parts, technical support, and training for these systems and missiles.

This certification and the attached justification shall be made part of the certification transmitted to the Congress under section 36(b)(1) of the Act with respect to each of the above sales. This certification shall be published in the Federal Register.
